

## Request for Extension to Serve

The Civil Resolution Tribunal (CRT) Rules require that respondents be served with a copy of the Dispute Notice and instructions for response.



In many cases the CRT will serve the respondents. If the CRT notifies you that you must serve the Dispute Notice and instructions for response, then you must serve the Dispute Notice and instructions for response on each respondent within 90 days of the date the CRT issued the Dispute Notice.

If you don't serve the respondents with the Dispute Notice and instructions for response before this deadline, or request an extension, the CRT may dismiss or refuse to resolve the dispute.
